[Delicate Spots] is a web application designed to prevent sexual violence among young people. It deals with sex-related topics, such as first sexual experiences and sexual violence.



TOPICS ADDRESSED

The narrative game is divided into five scenarios in which a group of teenagers are having a get-together. [Delicate Spots] allows players to experience, within a safe setting, the impact of decisions they make for the game's characters.

Who is this game designed for?

The game is intended for all high school students.

- How long does it take to play?

 Each scenario takes approximately 15 to 20 minutes to complete. When used along with the teaching activities suggested in our companion guide, expect 75 minutes per scenario.
- Where can I get the game?

 A 90-minute training course is offered to you free of charge

A 90-minute training course is offered to you free of charge to familiarize yourself with the mechanics of the game, the scenarios and the possible animation style. WHY THIS GAME?

This game is a practical, engaging, and innovative tool to teach young people about sexuality and the prevention of sexual violence. The topics addressed in the scenarios were chosen after consultation with adolescents from different walks of life. They were then revised by a team of professionals at Marie-Vincent to ensure their alignment with mandatory content in sexuality education and real-life issues faced by young people, and developed for the game by the Alice & Smith agency.

HOW TO USE IT?

We recommend incorporating one or more scenarios into the mandatory content in sexuality education activities taught in the classroom. The companion guide for high school staff suggests pedagogical activities for each game scenario.
