About

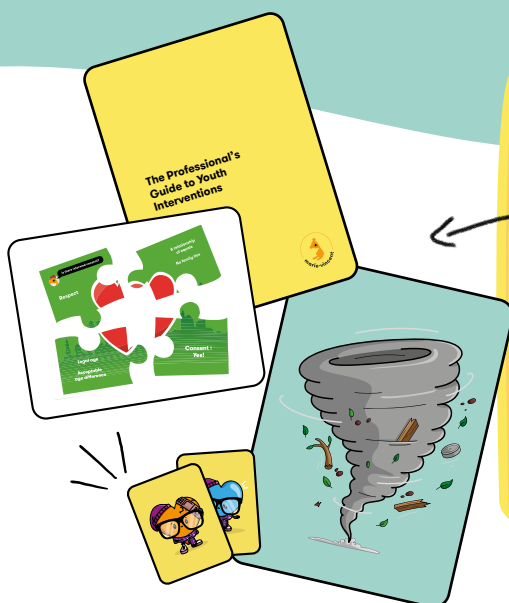
To support children and teens who have been victims of sexual violence, Marie-Vincent provides *All the services they need under one roof in conjunction with our partners.*

Marie-Vincent helps prevent violence through education and awareness and by assisting children with sexual behaviour problems, in keeping with the vision to build a protective community that will ensure the optimal development of all young people.

→ What is it about?

The kit contains *The Professional's Guide to Youth Interventions* and is available in English and French. It was developed by Marie-Vincent based on the sexual exploitation cycle devised by Fleury and Cadette (2002).

Their theory is that a young person can potentially experience eight (8) distinct stages within a sexual exploitation cycle. From this premise, we implement effective interventions and deploy the appropriate tools for the stage of the sexual exploitation cycle the young person is in.



✓ Which users was the kit designed for?

The kit was designed for use by professionals working with at-risk young people and those who are in a situation of sexual exploitation.

✓ Kit contents

- Two intervention guides, one in French and one in English, with detailed descriptions of the 27 recommended tools.
- Enlarged reproductions of some tools in dry-erase format
- Playing cards and puzzles

Directions for use

Each section of the intervention guide corresponds to a stage in the sexual exploitation cycle and contains detailed recommended interventions and tools. You will find a digital version of the tool on our website or you may acquire a physical copy of the guide and the kit.

Training is also provided, free of charge, to users who want a detailed look at each tool and concrete examples for using them. **The guide is available free on our website.**
